
# Crossfield United Church Announcements - Nov.13, 2025

- Luke 20:20-26.




A denarius from ca. 14 - 37 AD with the Emperor Tiberias depicted. He lived from 42 BC - 37 AD. Reference to "AUGUSTUS" ties Tiberias to the legacy of the first emperor. "TI-CAESAR" declares his reign has leader of Rome. A denarius = one day's wages.

## What's Happening at Crossfield United this Sunday





Deadline is November 23<sup>rd</sup>.








### **Crossfield United "Nativi-Tea"**
