As the weeks of Advent progress, the focus shifts to thanks and praise for the birth of the One who has already come - Jesus Christ our Savior.

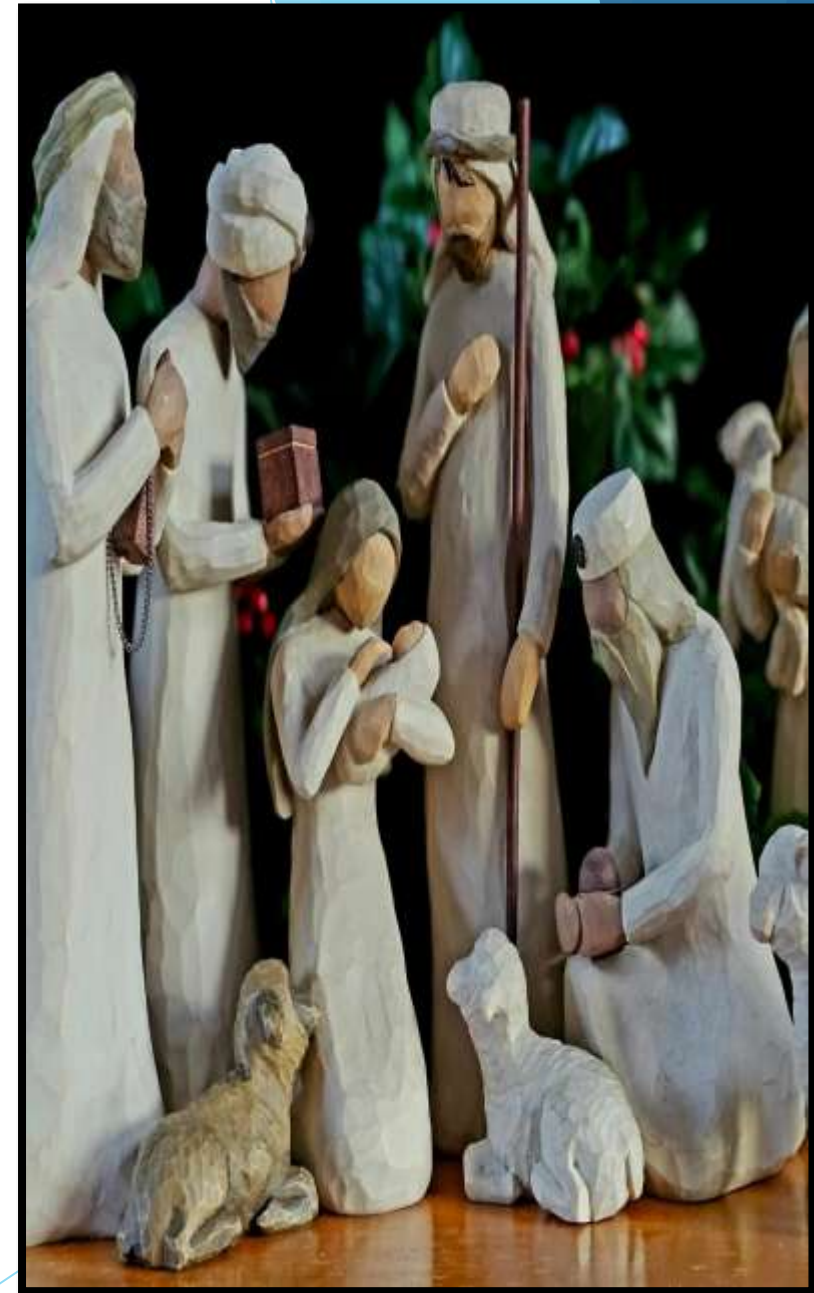

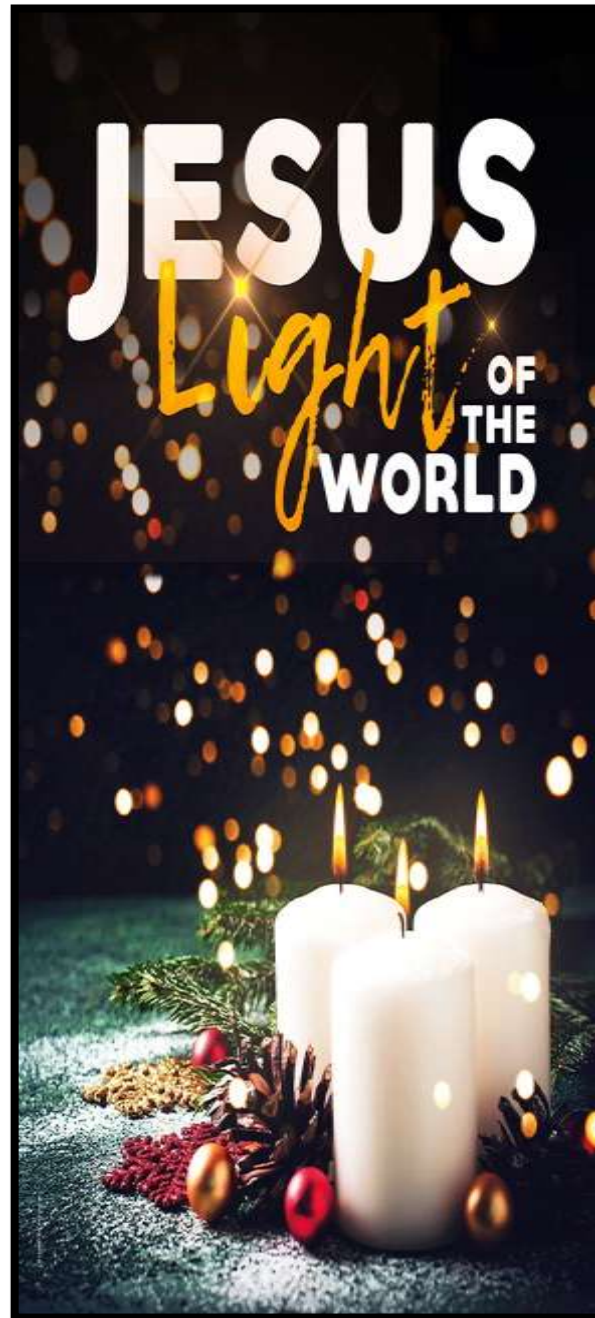
